

Circumcision Postoperative Care

- Avoid cycling, riding motorcycle, driving car or doing strenuous exercises after the operation.
- After the procedure, you will still have some swelling and pain on the wound of the penis and approximately 2-3 weeks will gradually subside
- Wear loose trousers to prevent contamination of wound from the urine.
- Do not change dressing by yourself without your doctor's advice
- The wound sutures do not need to be removed. These will fall off naturally by itself.
- There will be some ecchymosis around the penis and scrotum and it will gradually subside approximately 2 weeks.
- Refrain from sexual activities within 3 weeks after the procedure.
- Take medications as prescribed by your doctor and come back for follow-up.
- If you notice any of the following conditions please contact us immediately.
 - (1) Abnormal bleeding from wound.
 - (2) Wound swelling and even scrotal discoloration.
 - (3)Fever.
