

Vasectomy Postoperative Care

- Both couples should agree to sign the consent for the operation.
- There will be some bleeding around the wound normally, if severe seek immediate consult.
- Avoid doing strenuous and rough activities after the operation.
- Keep the wound dry.
- Take medications as prescribed by your doctor and come back for follow-up.
- Allow normal sexual activity after 1 week of operation.
- After vasectomy operation there will be normal secretion of testosterone and not influence the sperm amount and quality.
- The procedure just cause no sperm in your ejaculation. Therefore will not influence your health and normal sexual acitivity.
- If you have severe wound pain after the procedure use ice packing or take medicine.
- After vasectomy procedure, there will be residual sperm in your testes.
- You will need to wear a condom or your partner can also use a form of birth control to prevent getting pregnant.
- A sample of your ejaculate will need to be tested after about 15-20 times of ejaculation or 3 moths after the procedure during your follow up visit to make sure there is no sperm in your ejaculate.
- If you notice any of the following conditions please contact us immediately.
 - (1) Abnormal bleeding from wound.
 - (2) Scrotal swelling and pain.
 - (3) Abnormal pus discharge from wound
